

however, AI CISO-bots can't...

- Align Security with Business...
- Conquer and cultivate soft skills
- Meticulously select AI ethical boundaries [5]
- Ban AI if unacceptable risk (e.g. Stackoverflow [4])
- Compensate for new AI risks in S/W development [6]

- Clorox CISO departs after incident


CISOs leveraging Al...

- Customized apprenticeship for professionals [8]
- Al becoming a sine qua non feature in IDS's [9]




Luke, beware of the Dark Side...

- Amazing deepfakes (<u>10\$ 10 minutes</u>)
- Powerful attacker tools (e.g. PentestGPT) [10]
- Leaked copyrighted content used as AI input [10]
- All output violating copyright; user is not aware. [10]
- 45% of pros: biggest security challenges stem from AI [7]
- Effectiveness of <u>Business Email Compromise attacks beyond expectations</u>
